

## “Meet Me at the Well”

There are five women in Scripture who had encounters at wells. These five lessons are their stories. Although these women are not necessarily models for us to emulate, there are lessons to be learned from their lives. And we will learn about a different characteristic of God each week. At least one art card will accompany each lesson.

### **1.HAGAR:** *Egyptian Servant Girl* (Genesis 16, 21:9-21)

Introduction: wells in Bible lands and times

GOD = “The God who sees” (Gen. 16:3)

Memory verse: James 1:2-4 (NIV)

Art cards: #1 – Wells, #2 -- Hagar

### **2.REBEKAH:** *The Beautiful Bride* (Genesis 24:1-28, 58-67)

GOD = “God guided me” (Eliezer in Gen. 24:48)

Bonus study: biblical camels (art card #4--camel).

Memory verse: Psalm 32:8 (New Living Bible)

Art card: #3 -- Rebekah

### **3.RACHEL:** *The Displaced Bride* (Genesis 29-31)

GOD = God who is with us (Jacob in Gen. 28:15)

Bonus study: biblical sheep (art card #6 – sheep).

Memory verse: John 10:9-10 (NIV)

Art card #5 – Rachel

### **4.ZIPPORAH:** *The Reluctant Wife* (Exodus 2:11-25, 4:18-31, 18:1-27)

GOD = “God is my helper” (Moses in Exodus 18:4)

Bonus study: circumcision.

Memory verse: Psalm 121:1-2 (NIV)

Art card: #7 – Zipporah

### **5.SAMARITAN WOMAN:** *Spiritually Thirsty Woman* (John 4-42)

GOD = Jesus, the Living Water (John 4: 13-14)

Memory verse: John 4:13-14 (NIV)

Art card: #8 – Samaritan Woman
